



Noodle OOHs! (Everyone will say *Ooh* how cute!)

- 6 - 3mm Swarovski pearls (Light Green pictured)
- 2 - 5mm Swarovski pearls (Light Green pictured)
- 6 - 4mm Swarovski bicone crystals (Copper Crystal pictured)
- 2 - 6mm Swarovski bicone crystals (Copper Crystal pictured)
- 6 - 20mm long S-curved tubes
- 6 - 26gauge 2inch headpins
- 1.5-2.5inches of chain, depending on how long you want the earrings
- 1 pair of earwires (French wires pictured)

1. Slide on the beads in the following order:
 - 1st pair of headpins: 3mm pearl with a 4mm bicone on top (middle drop)
 - 2nd pair of headpins: 4mm bicone, 5mm pearl, and a 4mm bicone (shortest drop)
 - 3rd pair of headpins: 3mm pearl, 6mm bicone, and a 3mm pearl (longest drop)
2. Add a tube to each of the headpins. To do this insert your headpin as far as you can with your fingers. Once you've hit the point that you can't shove it in any more; use your chain nose pliers to push it the rest of the way. Grasp the headpin about 1/8inch from the tube and push; keep grasping about 1/8inch from the tube and pushing until your headpin comes out the other side of the tube. Then grab the top of the headpin and pull it so that the tube hits the beads. Do this for each of the headpins and tubes. Don't worry your headpins will have a bit of a curve to them.
3. Cut your chain to length. Pictured, the longest drop has a 1/2inch piece of chain; and the middle drop has a 1/4inch piece of chain. The shortest drop has no chain. If you like longer earrings, buy a little bit more chain and cut them closer to 3/4inch for the longest drop; 3/8inch for the middle drop; and 1/8inch for the shortest drop.
4. Wire wrap the headpins, making sure you add your chain sections before wrapping the loops shut. (You will defiantly need to wire wrap the headpins not one-loop-roll-over; the 26ga is too thin for a one-loop-roll-over.)
5. Open the loops on your earwires and add one of each of the headpin pairs to each on the earwires. Close your earwires nice and tight.
6. Wear and enjoy
